- Our chapter has focused primarily on the selling of merchandise/school spirit items
 - Sold lollipops from a company we met at the National Leadership Conference (http://ozarkdelight.com/)
 - For our school's pep rally, we sold bandannas corresponding with each class's color. In years past, we have sold small towels corresponding with each class's color.
 - Leading up to Christmas this year, we sold customized Milton ornaments for \$5 each
- Leading up to the National Leadership Conference we have gone around to local businesses and talked to them about what our club is/ how it benefits young adults at Milton High School. We transitioned this to asking if they'd be willing to sponsor us/donate money for our trip. This has been very successful.
- Overall, we have been able to do so well fundraising by simply putting the hours in
