

How to Study for Competitive Events - Newton South FBLA

- Go to the FBLA Competitive Event reference guide (<http://www.fbla-pbl.org/docs/ct/fblareferenceguide.asp>) and study the competencies. Make these competencies the center of what you study, and make sure that you know any terms or theories that they ask for to define or explain. If it's not listed in some form on the competency list, it very likely will not be on the test.
- Often there will be flashcards for your competitive events on quizlet or similar sites
- Have chapter members who have partaken in competitive events give advice to members.
- If you're doing a presentation event be sure to review the rubric and look up examples of your event on YouTube.
